



When ordering socket outlets it should be noted that all appliances have varying power requirements. Therefore, we recommend that you check the reference tag, fitted to each appliance by law, to assess its power requirements and to enable you to order the correct socket. Failure to do so can lead to blowing the fuse not only on your stand, but also on the block mains, leaving you and your neighbouring exhibitors without lights or power. This may result in additional charges and delays on site. Current venue regulations state that sockets which are to be used for lighting must not exceed 1000w.

If you have any queries then please do not hesitate to discuss your requirements with our personnel. Listed below are examples of the socket ratings required for regularly used appliances.

NOTE: Most venues insist that all appliances are PAT tested by a competent electrician prior to exhibitors bringing their own equipment into the venue.

- Our quoted prices are based on the current costs of materials and labour. We reserve the right to pass on any increases in same which occur to the completion of any work.
- Orders and delivery dates are accepted subject to our being able to secure the necessary labour and materials. We accept no responsibility for non or part completion due to any cause beyond our control.
- Unless otherwise indicated, 100% of the listed price shall be paid on acceptance of the customers order.
- If we are prevented from completing any contract or executing work by any cause beyond our control, the customer shall pay us in proportion to the work completed and for all work done or obligations incurred on the exhibitor's behalf.
- If any customer, for whatever reason, fails to pay any account once it has fallen due, we reserve the right to recover our goods and to suspend delivery of further goods or the execution of further work under the contract to the company or any associated company, without prejudice, to our right to recover any loss sustained.
- All goods, materials, plant and machinery supplied by us, shall be on hire unless otherwise stated and shall be of sound construction and suitable for the purpose for which they are to be used. The customer shall reimburse us for any loss or damage to same whilst on hire.
- The period of hire will be the tenancy period of the exhibition unless otherwise stated. We shall enter the Exhibition premises to collect and to remove the items on hire as soon as permitted after the close by the exhibition organisers.
- We do not exclude our liability in respect of death, or personal injury of any party resulting from negligence of ourselves, our servants, or agents (but not of our sub-contractors, if any).
  - We do not exclude our liability for loss of, or damage to the exhibits or property of the customer where this has directly been caused by our negligence, provided that any claim in this respect is made in writing within 14 days of the problem having been brought to our notice.
  - Any claim resulting from (b) shall be limited to the amount of any loss of or diminution in value of the goods, and not in respect of any consequential costs incurred.
- Save as expressly provided in these conditions, the customer shall indemnify us against all actions, claims and demands whatsoever arising due to loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered by any party arising as a result of our conduct in completing the contract or by reason of us complying with any exhibition conditions.
- The customer shall comply with all conditions imposed by the Organisers or Promoters of the Exhibition and shall be solely responsible for obtaining written consent from these parties for any modifications or waiver of said conditions.
- We are not responsible for any injury, or injury to property or any loss or damage direct or indirect and of whatever nature caused or arising out of:
  - delay or failure to deliver goods or materials to carry out work from causes outside our control.
  - failure or defect in any goods or materials, plant or fittings not manufactured by us.
- We reserve the right to charge on to the customer any additional costs in association with the contract due to alterations incurred at the behest of the customer, the exhibitions promoter or the safety officers during the hire period.
- All quotations, designs, drawings, plans and models prepared by us remain our property and are copyright.

# electrical fixtures and fittings



120w spotlight

A general purpose spotlight for highlighting smaller exhibits, posters and graphics. Also available as a 300mm long arm fitting.



low voltage spotlight

A 50w low voltage halogen fitting giving a bright white beam of light, with a low heat output and integral transformer. Ideal for highlighting natural colours in exhibits.



300w halogen floodlight

Provides a broad beam of white halogen light, useful to flood big exhibits or large display areas. Also available as a 500mm long arm fitting. NOTE: These fittings must be placed at a height of 2.25m or above, due to their high heat output.



50w long arm spotlight

A 50w halogen fitting on a 300mm long arm. Ideal for highlighting posters and graphic material.



75w long arm spotlight

A 75w halogen fitting on a 300mm long arm. Similar to the 50w fitting but much brighter. Ideal for highlighting posters and graphic material.



low voltage downlighter

A 50w low voltage halogen fitting giving a bright white beam of light. Available as a straight downlighter or as an adjustable eyeball. NOTE: Space is required for the remote transformer close to the fitting.



soft wind fan

Provides a soft movement of air. Useful in areas which are prone to a build up of heat, such as under lights.



100w wall light

A 100w fitting, fixed to a wall, emitting a soft level of lighting. Ideal for lounge areas.



70w metal halide floodlight

Provides a powerful, broad beam of white light as used in retail shops. Good for highlighting wall mounted exhibits.



long arm 150w halogen floodlight

A silver fitting with a 400mm long arm giving a broad beam of white halogen light, useful to flood big exhibits. NOTE: These fittings must be placed at a height of 2.25m or above, due to their high heat output.



fluorescent fittings

Available in a variety of standard lengths, these fittings provide a good level of general illumination to stands. Note: not suitable for highlighting specific exhibits.

ceiling battens

All of the fittings above, with the exception of the wall lights and downlighters, will require additional ceiling battens, unless fixed to the back of the shell scheme fascia board or stand walls.



water heaters

Two types are available - a 2000W heater filled by an attached hose or a plumbed in 3000W heater. NOTE: Please ensure that you order the appropriately rated spur connection unit.



mains boxes

Under current venue regulation each stand must have its own fuse board in an accessible position. Please indicate your preferred position for this board. NOTE: In most venues, some stands will also accommodate a venue mains box.
