### extracts from our terms & conditions

1. Our quoted prices are based on the current costs of materials and labour. We reserve the right to pass on any increases in same which occur to the completion of any work.
2. Orders and delivery dates are accepted subject to our being able to secure the necessary labour and materials. We accept no responsibility for non or part completion due to any cause beyond our control.
3. Unless otherwise indicated, 100% of the listed price shall be paid on acceptance of the customers order.
4. If we are prevented from completing any contract or executing work by any cause beyond our control, the customer shall pay us in proportion to the work completed and for all work done or obligations incurred on the exhibitor's behalf.
5. If any customer, for whatever reason, fails to pay any account once it has fallen due, we reserve the right to recover our goods and to suspend delivery of further goods or the execution of further work under the contract to the company or any associated company, without prejudice, to our right to recover any loss sustained.
6. All goods, materials, plant and machinery supplied by us, shall be on hire unless otherwise stated and shall be of sound construction and suitable for the purpose for which they are to be used. The customer shall reimburse us for any loss or damage to same whilst on hire.
7. The period of hire will be the tenancy period of the exhibition unless otherwise stated. We shall enter the Exhibition premises to collect and to remove the items on hire as soon as permitted after the close by the exhibition organisers.
8. a) We do not exclude our liability in respect of death, or personal injury of any party resulting from negligence of ourselves, our servants, or agents (but not of our sub-contractors, if any).  
b) We do not exclude our liability for loss of, or damage to the exhibits or property of the customer where this has directly been caused by our negligence, provided that any claim in this respect is made in writing within 14 days of the problem having been brought to our notice.  
c) Any claim resulting from (b) shall be limited to the amount of any loss of or diminution in value of the goods, and not in respect of any consequential costs incurred.
9. Save as expressly provided in these conditions, the customer shall indemnify us against all actions, claims and demands whatsoever arising due to loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered by any party arising as a result of our conduct in completing the contract or by reason of us complying with any exhibition conditions.
10. The customer shall comply with all conditions imposed by the Organisers or Promoters of the Exhibition and shall be solely responsible for obtaining written consent from these parties for any modifications or waiver of said conditions.
11. We are not responsible for any injury, or injury to property or any loss or damage direct or indirect and of whatever nature caused or arising out of:
  - i) delay or failure to deliver goods or materials to carry out work from causes outside our control.
  - ii) failure or defect in any goods or materials, plant or fittings not manufactured by us.
12. We reserve the right to charge on to the customer any additional costs in association with the contract due to alterations incurred at the behest of the customer, the exhibitions promoter or the safety officers during the hire period.
13. All quotations, designs, drawings, plans and models prepared by us remain our property and are copyright.
14. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, these Terms and Conditions apply to all contracts entered into by us to the exclusion of any terms and conditions contained in the customer's order which conflict or purport to modify them, and to the exclusion of any conditions of warranties implied by common law or statute.

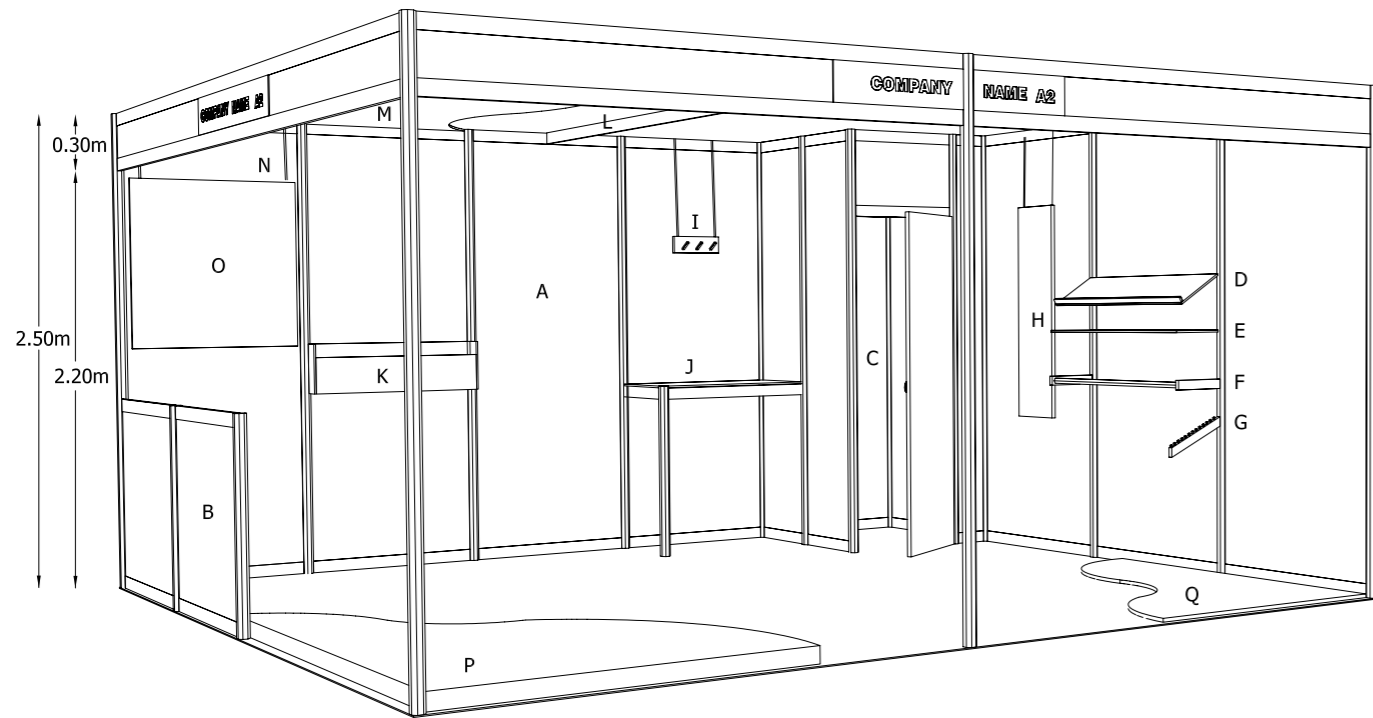

## your shell scheme

Your shell scheme stand will be constructed using a 2.5m high Click Modular System and consist of white melamine wall panels, framed in anodised aluminium at 1 metre centres (0.75m, 0.50m and 0.25m centres may be necessary depending on stand layouts).

Fascia panels are provided on open sides supported by aluminium posts at the corners and at mid-points where necessary. The maximum distance between support posts is 4 metres. An identification panel with your company name and stand number will be provided. Ceiling battens are positioned in the stand where necessary to give the structure rigidity.

### fixing of exhibits

Fixing of exhibits to the walls with nails, screws, staples etc. is NOT PERMITTED. The correct way of fixing your exhibits is by using twin velcro, Blu-tac etc. If wall panels are damaged in any way then a charge will be made for replacing the panels. No adhesives can be used on the shell scheme walls.

### shelves

Shelves are constructed from white melamine and fix to brackets inserted into aluminium uprights. Styles available are:

- D Fixed sloping shelves, sizes 1m & 2m lengths x 0.30m wide with front lip.
- E Fixed flat shelves, sizes 1m & 2m lengths x 0.30m wide.

### accessories

- F Garment rails, sizes 1m & 2m lengths set at 0.30m or 0.40m from the wall for displaying garments.
- G Waterfall garment rail with 13 notches.
- H Mirror on hanging straps - size of mirror 1.20m x 0.35m.
- I Hat & coat hooks (set of 3).
- J Melamine worktop with supports, 1m long x 0.50m wide.
- K Four pocket literature dispenser 1m wide, accommodates A4 literature.
- L Ceiling battens can be positioned over the stand to provide convenient fixing points for lighting.
- M White muslin ceiling (other colours are available).
- N Hanging chains (set of 2) can be fixed to customers own pictures, display boards etc., to hang in front of the wall panels.

### change of wall colour

To brighten up your stand why not add colour to the wall panels to match or contrast with your corporate colours? Wall panels can be supplied in different finishes; vinyl, felt and loop nylon colours. Colour samples and quotations are available on request.

### night sheets

Night sheets can be supplied, complete with padlocks, securing the open sides of stands.

### wall panels

Wall panels are available to match the shell scheme and provide partitioning, offices, storerooms etc.

- A 2.5m high x 1m wide (also available in widths of 0.75m, 0.50m, 0.25m).
- B 1m high x 1m wide (dwarf wall panels).

### display panels

Display panels are available in a range of colours and can be used for fixing graphics, cut out lettering, small exhibits etc.

- O1 0.90m high x 0.90m wide.
- O2 0.90m high x 1.98m wide.

### raised platforms

P Raised platforms (covering required) with a black painted skirting are a convenient way to route electrics, plumbing or other cable runs to areas in the centre of a stand.

### doorways

Doorways can be formed with either a lockable door section or with a curtained entrance.

- C1 Lockable door sections are 2.5m high x 0.75m wide.
- C2 Curtained entrance sections are 2.5m high x 1m wide with an opening of 2m high.

### flooring

Some halls are carpeted throughout and where this cannot be lifted and you wish to change the colour or type of floorcovering, it is necessary to lay flooring flats as a base.

- Q Flooring flats (covering required).
